1. The data controller

2. What are cookies?

When you visit a website, the latter can store information on your browser, or retrieve information from it, mainly through the use of cookies.

Cookies are small text files (strings of letters and numbers) that contain information. Every time you visit a website, these text files are transmitted by the server to the browser, which stores them inside itself. The relevant ID is then retransmitted to the sender every time the browser loads a page from the server.

The information retrieved from cookies can be related to you, your preferences, the computer with which you connected to the website, and can be used to operate the website according to your expectations.

Usually cookies do not contain information that can identify you and are aimed solely at allowing you a personalized and smooth browsing experience.

However, sometimes cookies managers may connect some of your personal details already in its possession with certain information contained in the cookies.

3. Different kinds of cookies

First / third party cookies

Cookies can be installed by the owner of the website that the user is visiting ("first-party cookies") or by the owner of other websites ("third-party cookies").



Persistent / session cookies

Some cookies are stored permanently within your computer until the expiration of their duration or until they are deleted by the user ("persistent cookies"); others are automatically deleted every time the user stops browsing the website or closes the browser ("session cookies").

Technical cookies

Technical cookies are used for the sole purpose of making electronic transmission possible or are strictly necessary for the electronic service provider to provide the user with the requested service. They can be divided into:

- browsing and session cookies: they guarantee regular browsing on and usage of a website (e.g., they allow access to restricted areas);
- analytical cookies: they allow to monitor the use of the website pages for statistical investigation purposes;
- functional cookies: they allow to set criteria for browsing the website (e.g., language).

These cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the website and are not used for other purposes. Your consent is **NOT NECESSARY** for the use of these cookies.

Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are aimed at creating specific user profiles. They are used to transmit advertising messages to users in line with the preferences shown during navigation. A website can operate without these cookies without this compromising the user's browsing experience in any way. Your consent is **NECESSARY** for the use of these cookies.

Cookies that require consent

Your consent is necessary for the use of profiling cookies.

StageAir will keep track of each consent through a specific technical cookie, so that every time you return to the website the banner will no longer be shown to you. 7. Your rights

With regard to the processing activities mentioned in this information, you can exercise the rights listed in this section, as enshrined in articles 15 to 21 of the GDPR. In particular:

- **Right of access** - article 15 of the GDPR: to obtain confirmation of whether or not your personal data are being processed and, in such case, receive information regarding: purposes of the processing, categories of data processed and retention period, recipients to whom these can be communicated, etc.
- **Right to rectification** - article 16 of the GDPR: to obtain, without undue delay, the rectification of your data, if incorrect, or the integration of incomplete ones.
- **Right to erasure** - article 17 of the GDPR: to obtain, without undue delay, the erasure of your personal data in the cases provided for by the same article.
- **Right to restrict the processing activity** - article 18 of the GDPR: to obtain the restriction of the processing activities in the cases provided for by the same article.
- **Right to data portability** - article 20 of the GDPR: to receive, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, your personal data and obtain that they are transmitted to another controller without hindrance, in the cases provided for by the same article.
- **Right to object** - article 21 of the GDPR: to object, at any time, to the processing of your personal data, unless there are legitimate grounds for the Controller to continue the processing activity.
- **Right to withdraw the consent** - article 7 of the GDPR: to withdraw the previously expressed consent with the same simplicity with which it was given.
